### **Terms of Reference for Board Directors**

The director responsible as:

### **Chairman of the Board**

1.           **Role**           The Chairman is elected by the Council and is responsible for the performance and accountability of the Board in all matters relating to the agreed policy of the Federation.
  
2.           **Responsibility**           The Chairman, working with the Chief Executive, is responsible for:
  - the development of policy and budgets
  - representing the interests of the Council, stakeholders and executive
  - liaising with and promoting the Federations interests to the Member Body Chairmen
  - accountability for the delivery of agreed policy and targets
  - representing the Federation to the FEI as the “BEF President”, in particular covering:
    - promoting GBs best interests and building GBs influential representation within the FEI
    - bidding and securing major events for GB
  - representing the Federation at Board level to London 2012 from an Olympic Games organisational prospective
  - acting as the Chief Executive’s line manager
  
3.           **Objective**           The Chairman’s objective is to lead the Board in achieving the targets set by the Council.
  
4.           **Method**           While the Chairman is responsible for governance and policy matters, the executive will be responsible for supporting the process of developing strategy and preparing budgets and for implementing strategy once it is agreed.
