Clubmark, introduced in 2002, is the Sport England mark of high quality clubs, reassuring both parents and participants that the club is a high quality, welcoming environment for young people.

The mark is awarded to clubs that can satisfy minimum operating requirements in the four areas of:

- The playing programme
- Duty of care and child protection
- Knowing your club and its community
- Club management

What are the benefits of Clubmark accreditation for my club?
