Terms of Reference for Board Directors

[These terms should be read (at www.bef.co.uk) in conjunction with the Terms of Reference for The BEF Board and are supplementary to them.]

The director responsible for:

International Affairs

1. **Role** The Director for International Affairs is elected by the Council to assist in the governance of the Federation for all matters relating to the international activities of the Federation.
2. **Responsibility** The Director for International Affairs, working with the executive, is responsible to the Board in the subject area for:
 - the development of policy and budgets
 - representing the interests of the Council, stakeholders and executive
 - accountability for the delivery of agreed policy and targets
 - liaising with and promoting the policy to the relevant Member Body directors
3. **Objectives** The Director for International Affairs is to promote the development of policies throughout the Federation for:
 - Elite development and World Class:
 - Performance
 - Potential and Start
 - The delivery of teams ready to compete effectively at championships
 - Representing the Federation at Board level to UK Sport and the BOA in respect of international sport
 - International rules and regulations
4. **Method** While the Director is responsible for governance and policy matters, the executive will be responsible for supporting the process of developing strategy and preparing budgets and for implementing strategy once it is agreed.
