Terms of Reference for Board Directors

[These terms should be read (at www.bef.co.uk) in conjunction with the Terms of Reference for The BEF Board and are supplementary to them.]

The director responsible for:

Sports Development

1. **Role** The Director for Sports Development is elected by the Council to assist in the governance of the Federation in all matters relating to the development of sporting activities of the Federation.
2. **Responsibility** The Director for Sports Development, working with the executive, is responsible to the Board in the subject area for:
 - the development of policy and budgets
 - representing the interests of the Council, stakeholders and executive
 - accountability for the delivery of agreed policy and targets
 - liaising with and promoting the policy to the relevant Member Body directors
3. **Objectives** The Director for Sports Development is to promote the development of policies throughout the Federation for:
 - Coaching
 - Facilities
 - Long Term Athlete Development (LTAD)
 - Human medication and doping control
 - Safety
 - Volunteers
4. **Method** While the Director is responsible for governance and policy matters, the executive will be responsible for supporting the process of developing strategy and preparing budgets and for implementing strategy once it is agreed.
