

Time Guideline and participator briefing for Baileys Horse Feeds/British Breeding Futurity Young Horse Evaluations

Your individual numbers and evaluation time guidelines feature below.

The time guideline MAY VARY. It is intended as an indicator only. Please have your horse ready for the vet section in advance of the time indicated.

Before the evaluation, please buy or make a circular disc featuring your horse's number for both sides of your horse's bridle. Disc diameter approx 8-9cm.

If you would like your horse's passport officially stamped to confirm that he/she has been evaluated, along with the Premium Diploma obtained, please bring your passport to the secretary at the same time as you bring your horse so the identity can be verified.

Foals, yearlings and two year olds

Horses will be trotted up for the vet in a designated area before entering the arena. Please follow instructions from the vet on arrival. Please bring your score sheet with you from the vetting into the evaluation arena.

Horses will be admitted to the evaluation arena one at a time. Each evaluation takes approx 7 minutes (approx five horses in half an hour) and it is important that we keep to these timings.

Please enter the arena when indicated and stand your horse up square in front of the panel of evaluators. Following static evaluation, if you have a foal, this will now walk the triangle in hand following the dam once around the triangle. The foal will then be turned loose to follow the dam in trot once around the triangle.

Yearlings and two year olds will stand as above, then, when asked, walk the triangle once and trot the triangle once in hand. When trotting, please SHOW your horse, use the triangle as a guide only and trot wide so that the evaluators can see your horse moving. Please then return to the panel of evaluators to hear your score, verbal critique and collect your premium rosette. Your score sheet will be available for collection later.

The top two scores will receive a Champion and Reserve rosette. Please keep an eye on the scoreboard and if you have one of the top two scores, please return to the secretary or the Baileys representative to collect your rosette.

Three year olds

Please bring food to catch horses following loose evaluation.

Horses will be trotted up for the vet in a designated area before entering the arena. Please bring your score sheet with you into the evaluation arena from the vetting.

Horses will be admitted to the evaluation arena one at a time. Each evaluation will take approx 10 min.

Please enter the arena when indicated and stand your horse up square in front of the panel of evaluators. You will then be asked to walk once around the triangle and trot once around the triangle. When trotting, please SHOW your horse, use the triangle as a guide only and trot wide so that the evaluators can see your horse. Please then return to the panel of evaluators when you will be asked to turn your horse loose.

Dressage horses will have a minute loose and then be caught again and return to the panel of evaluators to hear your score, verbal critique and collect your premium rosette. Your score sheet will be available for collection later.

Show jumping and eventing horses can now be booted and will be presented at the jumping lane and permitted up to four tries down the lane which will consist of a cross pole and an upright, which will be progressed, over the four tries, to an upright and a parallel – max height 1m for horses and 70cm for ponies, unless you indicate otherwise. Loose paces will be evaluated at this time. Please then return to the panel of evaluators to hear your score, verbal critique and collect your premium rosette. Your score sheet will be available for collection later.

The top two scores will receive a Champion and Reserve rosette. Please keep an eye on the scoreboard and if you have one of the top two scores, please return to the secretary or the Baileys representative to collect your rosette.

Four year olds

Horses will be trotted up for the vet in a designated area before entering the arena, wearing a snaffle bridle. Please bring your score sheet with you from the vetting into the evaluation arena.

Please have your assistant bring your tack (and boots for the jumping phase, if appropriate) into the arena.

Please enter the arena when indicated and stand your horse up square in front of the panel of evaluators. You will then be asked to walk once around the triangle and trot once around the triangle. When trotting, please SHOW your horse, use the triangle as a guide only and trot wide so that the evaluators can see your horse.

Please then tack your horse up and work in for two minutes. Dressage horses and eventers must move in balance and with confidence in all paces and in a suitable outline for a young developing horse. The horse should accept the contact in trot and canter and, if possible, follow this pattern: -

- Trot down the centre line
- One circuit in trot on the left rein
- Change rein across diagonal and show lengthened strides

- One circuit in trot on right rein
- One circuit in canter on right rein
- Change rein across diagonal through trot
- One circuit in canter on left rein and show some lengthened strides
- Transition to trot and, on a 20 metre circle, allow the horse to stretch his neck (long rein)
- Collect reins, walk, change rein across diagonal with a free walk on long rein

Show jumpers must walk a 20m circle, trot a 20m circle and canter a 20m circle on both reins.

Show jumpers and eventers will then be asked to jump three fences up to 1m, one cross pole, one upright and one parallel. You may jump the cross pole twice in practice then proceed over the upright, followed by the parallel. In the event of a refusal, please calmly circle and try again. You may jump the course twice if you wish.

Please then return to the panel of evaluators to hear your score, verbal critique and collect your premium rosette. Your score sheet will be available for collection later.

The top two scores will receive a Champion and Reserve rosette. Please keep an eye on the scoreboard and if you have one of the top two scores, please return to the secretary or the Baileys representative to collect your rosette.

After the evaluation

Collect your score sheet and any rosettes from the official scorer before you go home. Results and a league table of the top scorers for each age group for each discipline will be available at www.bef.co.uk by the Monday following the evaluation, subject to staff availability at the BEF. An Active Stallion league table will also be posted. In any event scores will be posted as soon as possible.
