Awards for All is a joint Lottery grants scheme aimed at local communities, which awards grants of between £300 - £5,000 over one year and up to £10,000 over two years. It can help your organization or community by funding projects for people to take part in a wide range of community activities and projects (e.g. sports, health, environment etc).

£10,000 is the maximum that can be received in any two year period.

Applications can be made at any time using the short and simple application form, available for download from the website or by telephoning the above number, and a reply will be received reply within 8 weeks.

Who can apply?

- a not-for-profit group, including sports clubs
- a parish or town council
- a school/health body

Applicants need to have a bank account that requires at least two people to sign each cheque or withdrawal, and must be able use the grant within one year.

The aims of Awards for All are to:

- extend access and participation
- increase skill and creativity
- and improve the quality of life

A grant could be spent on: equipment (sports equipment, musical instruments, computers, educational toys and games); volunteers' expenses; venue hire; transport costs; training; seasonal staff; feasibility studies; and much more.

Grants cannot be awarded to companies which aim to distribute a profit, statutory bodies not mentioned above, and individuals.

Applications will also be assessed and scored against a set of national and regional criteria defined in the accompanying guidance notes, but your project does not have to deliver one or more of these outcomes to be considered for funding (although priority will be given to those that do).
