

Role title	Role description	Criteria
Administration Team Member	Provide administrative and other support to Competition Management Team	Experience supporting an Organising Committee of an FEI Event; preferably at 3* level or above, ideally in a multi discipline environment.
Technical Officials Team Member	Support Management of Technical Officials and Volunteer Workforce.	Overall knowledge of equestrian sport as well as discipline specific.
Stables Team Member	Assist stables manager supporting grooms and riders, ensuring efficient and smooth running of stables compounds.	Experience of working in an FEI Stables that has required Stable Security. Able to assist in the movement of bedding, forage and with the loading / unloading of horseboxes.
Stewards	Steward stabling, training and warm up areas - majority will be listed FEI stewards but also includes a small team for final ring call up, ring management/communication who may not be FEI stewards (Field of Play Front Desk)	Stewards will require to be qualified FEI Stewards (minimum Level). Field of Play Front Desk Stewards (not necessarily FEI Stewards) should have carried out a similar role at an FEI Event at 3* level or above (ability to speak a foreign language would be an advantage).
Field of Play Team Member	Building show jumping courses, arena party duties, setting up dressage arena and A-gate team for dressage	Experience as part of an arena party at a minimum of three FEI Jumping competitions and ideally at a mixed Dressage /Jumping FEI competition. For A-gate team will demonstrate an understanding of dressage and competence in the role.
Eventing Officials Team Member	Specific roles such as	
	Sector Stewards	Must have recent (last 3 years) experience in this role at FEI 3* CCI level or above or be an experienced BE or FEI accredited official.
	Controller and control team members	Must have recent (last 3 years) experience as a controller at major international event(s) or in a control team at FEI events
	D Box Stewards	Must have recent (last 3 years) experience in this specific role at FEI 3* CCI level or above.
Fence Judge	Judge each horse/rider at cross country obstacle	
	Senior Fence Judge:	Must have regularly judged at major international events from FEI 2* upwards in the last 3 years and be recommended by at least 2 Organisers of BE or FEI Events.
	Assistant Fence Judge	Must have regularly judged at events at Intermediate or higher level in the last 3 years and be recommended by at least 2 Organisers of BE or FEI Events.
Timing Team Member	Manage and steward Start and Finish of cross country, Time Keepers and Stopping Point teams.	Must have regular experience, within the last 3 years, in any of these roles at international events.
Eventing Warm Up Steward	Oversee and steward cross country warm up area	Must have regularly assisted at 3/4* CIC/CCI events during the last 3 years
Crossing Point Steward	Man ropes and stewarding of spectators at cross country course crossing points	Must have regularly assisted at FEI events that have significant spectator attendance during the last 3 years
Sport Info Team Member	Provide information to riders and team officials at venue and Olympic / Paralympic Village	Must fully understand the Olympic/ Paralympic equestrian competition formats including processes for declarations. Should have a good understanding of the FEI Olympic/ Paralympic Rules. Should be IT literate and ideally have worked in a similar role at FEI 3* or above competitions. Ability to speak a foreign language is advantageous.
Dressage Writers	Record scores and remarks of judges	Must have carried out this role at 3* or 4* CIC / CCI OR CDI/CDIO/CPEDI 3* (or above) events during the last 3 years and be able to demonstrate competence in the role. Priority will likely be given to BD list 1 or 2 judges.
Scoring Support Team	Record and monitor scoring of all disciplines, score in-putting and manual checking/confirming including Field of Play positions (Jumping Start/ Finish, Water Jump, Dressage runners, button pushers etc.)	Must have regularly assisted at FEI events during the last 3 years and be able to demonstrate competence in the role. Ideally will have worked at a multi discipline event.
